The Centre of Excellence in Child Trauma C.I.C was created with a vision to make a difference in the lives of children and their families.

It brings together trainers, social workers, coaches, and therapists who have firsthand and lived experience in caring for children affected by early life trauma or displaying neurodiverse characteristics.

CoECT integrates cutting-edge research with expert knowledge and compassionate support for families. We recognise the unique challenges faced by parents and carers and are dedicated to providing the essential tools and guidance needed to navigate these complexities.

At COECT, we offer a wide range of services designed to support both parents and professionals.

This includes:

Help and Support - Our therapeutic services support families who require assistance with trauma-informed/therapeutic parenting as well as those needing relief from compassion fatigue symptoms. We also assist families on the edge of care and those families experiencing child-on-parent violence. We can provide support packages which are designed to provide compassionate assistance to families on the verge of crisis, offering a supportive hand during difficult times.

Training - Our comprehensive training courses cover topics such as Therapeutic and Trauma-Informed Parenting, Compassion Fatigue, and Strategies to Manage Behaviour. Our training is available both in-person and online.

Qualifications - We provide a variety of trauma-informed, accredited, customised qualifications with NCFE CACHE, ranging from level 1 to level 4 for parents and supporting professionals.

Resources and Peer Support - We provide access to a wealth of training, peer support, and well-being resources. This includes research, articles, and practical tools designed to help families and professionals support children effectively.

Additionally, we offer a community where parents and caregivers can connect through our support groups called TIPs Meet-Ups. Our goal is to create a network of support and understanding through our Trauma-Informed Parents Hub membership.

Our membership subscription gives you access to peer support through our in-person and virtual Meet-ups, Supportive listening calls, Online Training Portal, Online Wellbeing Portal and Resources.

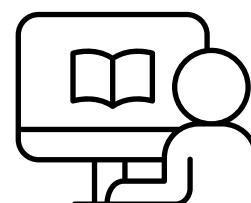
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ONLINE TRAINING PORTAL

(VIA THE TIPS HUB)

Our Online Training Portal provides essential resources and training for anyone supporting children who have faced early life trauma. This includes an introduction to therapeutic parenting techniques, strategies for managing various challenging behaviours, and guidance for professionals working with children who have experienced adverse childhood experiences.

Members will gain insights into the effects of trauma, access expert-led webinars, and receive tips for collaborating with schools. Additionally, the pass offers techniques for addressing anxiety, navigating support systems, and self-care strategies for Parents, Carers and Supporting Professionals who work with families.

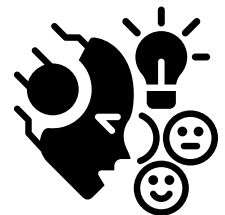

We offer both virtual and in-person options nationwide, facilitated by dedicated CoECT Volunteers.



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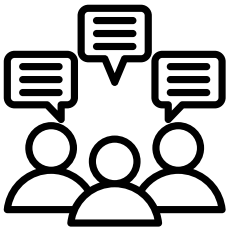
FAMILY MEET-UPS

SUPPORTIVE LISTENING CALLS

Sometimes, we just need to be heard and have someone listen to us in order for us to make sense of a situation. As part of the TIPs Hub membership, members will be entitled to one supportive listening call per month, which can be booked online.

Extra sessions a month can be arranged at an additional cost of £25 per hour (plus VAT). Non-members are also welcome to use this paid service.



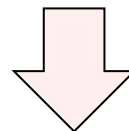
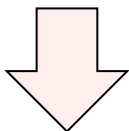
CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP PRICES

Membership Sign up

When signing up for membership, you will be guided through the process by a member of our corporate membership support team.



A team member will contact you to arrange a meeting via Teams or Zoom to discuss your membership requirements.



Once the number of memberships to be purchased is confirmed, an invoice will be sent to you.



On receipt of payment, our team will request details of the individuals who will be signed up for membership and will add them to the portal.
If you have allocated spaces for memberships instead of individuals, typically used for prospective foster parents or adopters who will be joining your organisation, you will be given a code to provide to them upon sign-up.



Once your membership begins, you will receive a paper copy of our bi-monthly magazine. This magazine will include articles, information, and updates about our services.
Additionally, you will have the opportunity to schedule a consultation with us to discuss personalised training packages that complement your membership.
